On July 17, 2020, Nexans and Leviton have achieved an important milestone by signing a purchase agreement for Leviton to acquire Berk-Tek LLC, a leading manufacturer of local area network cables. The agreement includes all Berk-Tek employees and Berk-Tek's manufacturing facilities in New Holland, PA and in Fuquay-Varina, NC. Berk-Tek will remain a Nexans company until the transaction closes in Q3 2020. Upon closing, Berk-Tek will become a Leviton company.

Leviton was founded in 1906. It is a privately held company and their global headquarters is located in Melville, New York. After closing, Berk-Tek will be part of Leviton's Network Solutions division based in Bothell, Washington.
